Purpose

- Scholarships are in memory of Tom Perry and Betty Smith and are valued between \$500 and \$1000.

Who Are We

- Physicians for Global Survival (PGS) is a Canadian Non-Governmental Organization dedicated to the prevention of nuclear war.
- We are the Canadian affiliate of International Physicians for the Prevention of Nuclear War which won the 1985 Nobel Peace Prize.

Eligibility

- Students at any level of study, in any field, in a Canadian University
- Projects may be part of students course work but must reflect aspects of the PGS mission statement
- An independent report is required for PGS for national and international distribution

Timeline:

- **August 30, 2016: 4 PM Deadline** for submission (by E-mail pgsadmin@web.ca)
- **September 30, 2016:** Notification of Research Scholarships to be awarded
- **December 31, 2016:** Awards distributed (or earlier depending on research completion)

Applications should include:

1. Application Cover sheet including Name; Address; Contact information; Title of Proposed Research Project; Year, Program and Institution of Study
2. Project summary (1 paragraph)
3. Project description & its relation to the PGS mission statement (1-2 paragraphs maximum)
4. Project Time Line
5. Disclosure of association with course work and other sponsorship in process or secured.
